7. . Talking about the growth of Auckland, the Rural Urban Boundary (RUB) will define the maximum extent of urban development in Greenfield (undeveloped) land to help meet the growth projected in the Auckland Plan.

The RUB will be included in the Unitary Plan. The Auckland Plan intends for up to 40 per cent of the required new dwellings to be located in rural towns and villages, greenfield areas and other rural areas; the majority of new dwellings will be located in existing urban areas.

The purpose of the RUB is to provide adequate room for growth while protecting the things that Aucklanders hold special, such as the natural environment, heritage, productive rural land, valued coastal areas and sense of community.

Thinking about the RUB in terms of Muriwai's future development please choose the response that best suits your feeling on how a RUB might affect our

community?

I think that Muriwai should retain its Coastal Character and not be developed further, the RUB should start before Kumeu.

I think further subdivision should be allowed within the township, but that the farmland/rural areas should remain as they are.

I think further subdivision should be allowed within the township, and that the farmland areas should be allowed to be sub-dividable to the current minimum size - 1200m².

I think that there should be no subdivision below a minimum size without appropriate infrastructure in the Village and that rural land subdivision should be restricted to large lots to retain the rural character.

I cannot make a decision until I have more information about what the Council is intending in the Unitary Plan.

I have no opinion one way or the other.

None of the above options are suitable I think that there are other solutions.

8. Auckland Council has identified the area stretching from Westgate to Helensville as having the potential for node-based (around existing settlements) growth in future.
